ABOUT SUDAN AND THE SEMA

Africa's largest nation, SUDAN, about one-quarter the size of the US and having approximately 35 million inhabitants, is in the midst of a humanitarian crisis due to a long-standing conflict between the people of the north and south of the country, and as a result of regional instability. Over the past several decades, the internal and regional conflicts have left the nation's infrastructure and health care systems in less than desirable conditions. Thereby people continue to endure poor health conditions, particularly in the Darfur region. The SEMA proposes to assist the health care community of southern Sudan (Juba) in its effort to provide medical care to a small part of the country's people. This project also provides a unique opportunity for the health workers of the world to gain a first-hand experience in the country and to provide medical assistance during the crisis as the nation anticipates its post-crisis reconstruction and rehabilitation period. We invite you to join The African Cultural Exchange in this effort.
